

MONTHLY SUMMARY OF PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES/ DEVELOPMENT IN RESPECT OF DEPARTMENT OF SPORTS DURING THE MONTH OF JULY, 2019.

The month of July, 2019 has been a month of noticeable achievements for athletes in International Events. Some of these are as follows :-

- (i) India topped the medal tally at the Commonwealth Weightlifting Championships, 2019 held in Apia, Samoa from July 9-14, 2019 in both Junior and Senior age groups by winning 35 medals (22 golds, 10 silvers and 3 bronze medals) across the three age groups, with 32 different athletes (15 men and 17 women). This is India's best ever performance in this tournament.
- (ii) India grabbed all the gold medals (seven) in the 21st Commonwealth Table Tennis Championship held in Cuttack (India).
- (iii) Hima Das won five gold medals within 20 day period in various International Athletics Events. This is her best ever performance in 200m and 400m race.
- (iv) Dutee Chand became the first Indian woman athlete to win a gold medal at the World Universiade in a 100m sprint event.
