Monthly Report for the month of June, 2022

Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports

1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

- a) The fourth edition of the Khelo India Youth Games (KIYG), which was delayed due to Pandemic, was successfully organised in Panchkula, Haryana from 04.06.2022 to 13.06.2022. Over 4700 competitors from 36 States and Union Territories participated in KIYG across 25 different disciplines including 5 indigenous games. The State of Haryana topped the medal tally followed by Maharashtra and Karnataka in the KIYG, 2021. Several national records were created in the KIYG, 2021 in various sports disciplines including weightlifting, and athletics.
- b) The Hon'ble Prime Minister launched the first-ever "Torch Relay for the Chess Olympiad" on 19th June, 2022 at Indira Gandhi Stadium, New Delhi. This torch is being taken to 75 iconic locations across the Country in a span of 40 days before it finally reaches Mahabalipuram, Tamil Nadu, the venue of the Chess Olympiad. A total of 189 countries will be participating in this edition of Chess Olympiad, which will be organised between 28th July, 2022 & 10th August, 2022.
- c) A two-day National Conference of Ministers in charge of Youth Affairs & Sports of States/UTs was held at Kevadia (Gujarat) between 24th & 25th June, 2022 to deliberate and discuss the way forward for a unified approach to strengthen India's sporting ecosystem. Ministers in-charge of Youth Affairs and Sports from 15 States/UTs and Senior Officials from 33 States/UTs participated in the Conference, presided over by the Hon'ble Union Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports.
- d) Other important activities during the period:
 - (i) The inaugural Khelo India Women National Ranking Weightlifting Tournament successfully organised between 14th & 22nd June 2022 at Nagrota Bagwan, Himachal Pradesh.
 - (ii) The inaugural Khelo India Women National Ranking Wrestling Tournament was successfully organised at Panchkula Haryana between 26th & 28th June 2022.
 - (iii) The 77th Meeting of Mission Olympic Cell (MoC) was held on 22.06.2022 on various components of the Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS), in which a proposal of Rs. 53,72,725/- was approved for 13 athletes of 6 sports disciplines (Wrestling, Athletics, Shooting ,Cycling, Swimming & Table Tennis).
 - (iv) National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) hosted a meeting for the Approval Committee of the Funds for Elimination of Doping in Sports and CoP8 Bureau

(UNESCO) on 21-22 June 2022 in New Delhi. India was unanimously elected as the Chair of the Fund for the Approval Committee for Elimination of Doping in Sports for the period of 2022-24 for the Asia Region.

- (v) 8th International Yoga Day was celebrated with various events organized at various locations including JLN Stadium (New Delhi) and SAI Regional Centres across the Country.

5. Status of ongoing Swachhta Abhiyan (progress under Special Campaign):

Following activities were conducted for the special campaign of Swachhta Abhiyan:

- a) White washing of staircase was completed in National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA). Apart from regular cleaning of the NADA premises, record rooms, server/electrical rooms and Dope Kits store rooms were also cleaned in the month of June under Swachhta Abhiyan activities.
- b) Swachhta Abhiyan is being carried out in Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) every week to keep the premises clean and hygienic. Biodegradable waste is composted at source and used in the Institute for maintaining grass, trees and playgrounds.
- c) Under Swachhata Abhiyan, Cleaning drives are organized every week in SAI Campuses all across the country. Activities like cleaning, sanitization and disinfection are carried out in SAI premises on a regular basis for the upkeep of cleanliness in the campus. Physical File movement has been stopped in various Offices and Divisions of Sports Authority of India to reduce the wastage of paper. Process of electronic file movement has been adopted for keeping the premises eco-friendly, clean and hygienic.

6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies - SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.

7. Information on specific steps taken for utilization of the Space Technology based tools and applications in Governance and Development:

The Department is co-ordinating with private companies to perform the geo-tagging of playfields on pan-India basis.
