Monthly D.O. letter for the month of February, 2022

Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports

1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

- a) Mission Olympic Cell Meeting (MOC) was held on 03.02.2022 and subsequently on 17.02.2022. Total 115 athletes were inducted in TOPS Core Group and 244 athletes were inducted in TOPS Development Group.
- b) A Meeting of Annual Calendar for Training and Competition (ACTC) was held on 10.02.2022 for the Federation of All India Sports Council of the Deaf (AISCD) and a budget of Rs. 6.97 Cr for the financial year 2022-23 was approved.
- c) Scientific Advisory Board (SAB) meeting of NDTL held on 23.02.2022:
 - Laboratory will schedule trainings covering focused areas like ESAs, biological testing, GC-C-IRMS, GC-MS, LCMS analysis, Peptides etc.
 - In the meeting, Publications and Patents for the new Reference material, in collaboration with NIPER-G, filed by NDTL were presented.
 - NDTL is planning to collaborate with IIT Delhi for strengthening its Biological Section. To strengthen R&D activities at NDTL, SAB suggested to identify thrust areas of research to collaborate with other scientific institutes of repute at National and International levels to promote R&D.
 - Two New Reference Material “Ethamivan Sulphate” and “17- Ketoprostanazol” has been synthesized with collaboration of CSIR-IIIM Jammu.
- d) With the approval of 12th High Powered Committee (HPC) dated 24.02.2022, following decisions were taken in the Sports Authority of India.
 - 6 academies are accredited under Khelo India Talent Development Scheme.
 - 434 Khelo India Athletes have been weeded out from Khelo India Scheme. A total of 161 Athletes were finalized for induction into Khelo India Scheme.
 - The policy guidelines to provide greater International Competition Exposure to NCOE athletes were finalised.

5. Status of ongoing Swachhta Abhiyan (progress under Special Campaign):

Following activities were conducted for the special campaign of Swachhta Abhiyan:

- a) Swachhta Abhiyan was performed at NDTL and the garbage disposed off. Monthly extensive cleaning by all staffs in the office cleaning of workstation by all the officials in NADA premises. White washing of the office space through CPWD, display of signage boards like 'No Smoking Area' and 'Do Not litter', etc were also carried out alongwith. Digitization of office files is in process and thereafter weeding out as per the manual of procedures, will be carried out in NADA.
- b) Special Campaign for Swachhta has been run by all the Institutional/Regional Head and Sr. Director Stadia Division and every division of Sports Authority of India. In their respective premises, Awareness posters of Swachhta among residents/visitors/Sportspersons were displayed at Regional centres. Removal of garbage/debris from premises of Centres is carried out every month. Also, Utmost attention is given for the cleanliness of campuses of Regional Centres.
- c) The Entire premise of the Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIFE) is kept clean and hygienic through cleaning/sweeping of the premise regularly. Besides this, the Institute has commissioned roof-top solar power plant and water harvesting systems are also in place in the buildings as well as grounds so that the drain water is not wasted.

6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies- SAI, LNIFE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.

7. Information on specific steps taken for utilization of the Space Technology based tools and applications in Governance and Development:

- a) National Anti-Doping Agency is adopting paper less Dope Control process.
- b) A request for proposal for engaging agency for geo-tagging of playfields across the country has been floated. A dashboard is being prepared for displaying information of playfields.

IMC has recommended the FDI proposal of City Football Group subject to the condition that subsequent to the approval, any further investment does not result in any increase in the prevailing shareholding percentage/stake of the shareholder(s)/investor(s) from country(ies) sharing land border with India; and does not vest new rights or entitlements which result in transfer of control of the Indian investee entity in favour of shareholder(s)/investor(s)/beneficial owner(s) from country(ies) sharing land border with India. Letter conveying the approval has been issued to City Football Group on 28 February 2022.
