Monthly D.O. letter for the month of March, 2022

Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports

1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

- a) Under Assistance to Nation Sports Federations (NSFs) Scheme of the Department, norms of providing financial assistance to various NSFs have been revised, which are effective from 1st March 2022. A comprehensive view has now been taken to cover important aspects of activities to enable rapid advancements in the field of sports in the country.
- b) Department of Sports appointed the Transaction Adviser (TA) for the development of Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium (JNS), Delhi as 'New Delhi Sports Hub' on Public-Private Partnership (PPP) basis. The first Key Deliverable (KD1) was submitted by the TA on 07.03.2022.
- c) Under 'Meet the Champions' campaign, Paralympian Shri Devender Jhahharia, visited Churu's Parakh Rajakiya Balika Uchha Madhyamik Vidyalaya on 7th March, 2022 while Paralympian Silver Medalist Shri. Yogesh Kathuniya visited Patna's Government Girls Senior Secondary School on 8th March, 2022 to discuss and share varied experiences in the area of sports, life lessons, tips on how to eat right, and also to give an overall inspirational boost to school children.
- d) Under FIT INDIA Quiz Programme, India's biggest Quiz for School children on Fitness and Sports, the State/UT finals for 36 States/UTs were conducted online on a virtual customized quiz platform from 11th to 17th March 2022.
- e) The Department has constituted a Mission Olympics Cell (MOC) comprising eminent ex-Olympians to advise and select the talent pool for the Olympic Podium. In the run-up to the Commonwealth Games, Birmingham, UK in August, 2022 and the Asian Games, Hangzhou, China in September, 2022, the MOC held two meetings in March. Similarly, for 24 Sports Disciplines the Annual Calendar for Training and Competition (ACTC) was also finalized in March, with a total budget of Rs. 244.08 Crore for the current financial year.
- f) The other important activities during the period are as follows:
 - i. In preparation of the Khelo India University Games, 2021 scheduled to start on 24th April, 2022 at Bangaluru, Karnataka, the Games Technical Conduct Committee held meetings to finalize the technical aspects of the preparations.

- ii. The Final Phase of Khelo India Women Hockey league (U-21) was conducted from 23.03.22 to 30.03.22 at Lucknow.
- iii. A recurring Grant of Rs. 7 lakh per centre was released to 25 new Khelo India Centre in three UTs/States of Delhi, Chhattisgarh & Andhra Pradesh under the "Sports for Women" Vertical of Khelo India Scheme.
- iv. A preparatory meeting was held with the World Anti Doping Agency for the Global Athlete Biological Symposium scheduled to be held in October, 2022 in New Delhi was held on 24th March, 2022.

5. Status of ongoing Swachhta Abhiyan (progress under Special Campaign):

Following activities were conducted for the special campaign of Swachhta Abhiyan:

- a) Swachhta Abhiyan was performed at NDTL and the garbage disposed off. Trees, plants and grass were planted at NDTL after cleaning the waste land. Monthly extensive cleaning by the officials in NADA. Files were inspected by concerned officials and were weeded out and sent to record room as per the manual of procedures.
- b) Special Campaign for Swachhta has been run by all the Institutional/Regional Head and Sr. Director Stadia Division and every division of Sports Authority of India. In their respective premises, Awareness posters of Swachhta among residents/visitors/Sportspersons were displayed at Regional centres. Also, utmost attention was given for the cleanliness of campuses of each Regional Centres.
- c) The Entire premise of the Lakshmbai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) was kept clean and hygienic and cleaning/sweeping operations were carried out.

6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies- SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.
