Annexure-I**Monthly Report for the month of October, 2022****Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports****1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:**

- a) The FIFA U-17 Women's Football World Cup India 2022 was inaugurated on 11th October, 2022 at Kalinga Stadium, Bhubaneswar. This is the second major football event the nation hosted in the last five years. Spain was crowned the Champions after defeating Colombia in the finals held in Mumbai on 30.10.2022.
- b) The 36th National Games were successfully concluded on 12th October, 2022 at Pandit Deendayal Indoor Stadium, Surat, Gujarat. The Services Sports Control Board (SSCB) topped the Medal Tally with 128 Medals (including 61 Gold), followed by Maharashtra and Haryana, in the Games.
- c) The Union Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports, in the presence of the Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh, formally announced the 5th Khelo India Youth Games to be hosted in Madhya Pradesh next year, in a ceremony held on 20th October, 2022.
- d) The third edition of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) Athlete Biological Passport (ABP) Symposium- 2022 was organized from 12th to 14th October, 2022 in New Delhi. Union Minister for Youth Affairs & Sports and other dignitaries addressed the opening session of the Symposium. ABP is a very important scientific tool in anti-doping and the related research which provides the world with an opportunity to not only detect but deter doping in sports. The Symposium helped to create a platform for experts around the world to deliberate recent trends, ongoing research and challenges with respect to ABP. Over 200 participants from 56 countries, WADA Officials, representatives and Experts from different National Anti-Doping Organizations, Athlete Passport Management Units (APMUs) and WADA Accredited Laboratories participated in the Symposium.
- e) A Memorandum of Understanding was signed on 15th October, 2022 between this Ministry, the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) and the National Forensic Sciences University (NFSU) for setting up dietary supplements testing facility. This is an affirming step in the direction of achieving 'Atmanirbhar' in the field of doping and dietary supplements.
- f) To promote inclusivity in sports by increasing the participation of women, the first Khelo India Women's Judo National League was hosted in the Indira Gandhi Stadium, New Delhi between 20th and 23rd October, 2022. In addition to that, Khelo India Women's Weightlifting Tournament was also organized between 28th October and 2nd November, 2022 for promotion of women's participation in sports.
- g) To commemorate "Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav", the 3rd Edition of Fit India Freedom Run was launched on 2nd October, 2022 envisaging promotion of fitness amongst the

citizens. The Fit India Freedom Run 3.0 was held from 2nd October 2022 till 31st October 2022.

- h) The Union Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports inaugurated a Water Sports Center in Bilaspur, Himachal Pradesh. A MoU was signed between Sports Authority of India and National Thermal Power Corporation Limited for the water sports academy to train athletes in sporting disciplines of rowing, kayaking, canoeing, etc.
- i) The 84th and 85th Meetings of Mission Olympics Cell (MOC) were held on 06.10.2022 and 21.10.2022 respectively on various components of Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS), in which proposals from various athletes belonging to 7 Sports disciplines worth Rs. 2,21,83,434/- were approved.
- j) The Special Campaign 2.0 was organized in this department in the Secretariat and in various organisation, viz. Sports Authority of India (SAI), Lakshmbai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE), National Sports University (NSU), National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) and National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) from 2nd October, 2022 to 31st October, 2022.

5. Status of ongoing Swachhta Abhiyan (progress under Special Campaign):

Following activities were conducted for the special campaign of Swachhta Abhiyan:

- a) Under Swachhta Campaign, the office premises of NADA including record room, electrical rooms and the workstations of officials were cleaned.
- b) Swachhta Campaign was carried out in the LNIPE, Gwalior campus where the entire premises were cleaned and waste was segregated at source. Biodegradable waste composted at source was utilised for maintenance of the green area.
- c) The entire premises of NDTL were cleaned and for eco-friendly disposal of waste, a manure pit was created.
- d) Cleanliness drive was conducted in various regional centres and training centres of SAI across the country.

6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies- SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.

7. Information on specific steps taken for utilization of the Space Technology based tools and applications in Governance and Development:

The geo-tagging of playfields and other sporting infrastructure across the country is under consideration.
