Monthly Report for the Month of February, 2023

Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports

1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1. The 5th edition of Khelo India Youth Games successfully concluded on 11th February, 2023 at Upper Lake, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh. Maharashtra topped the Medal Tally with 161 Medals (including 56 Gold Medals), followed by Haryana and Madhya Pradesh, in the Games. The Games saw 25 national records getting broken, including 19 records in weightlifting.
2. The 3rd Khelo India Winter Games were organized from 10th to 14th February, 2023 in Gulmarg, Jammu & Kashmir. The event saw the participation of over 2000 athletes. Jammu and Kashmir finished at the top in the Medals Tally with 76 medals including 26 Gold Medals, followed by Maharashtra and Himachal Pradesh. To further strengthen the sports ecosystem in the valley, 40 Khelo India Centres were launched by the Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports.
3. Various key infrastructure facilities were inaugurated in SAI centres across the country. This includes a 300-bedded hostel, a state-of-the-art wrestling hall, a sports medicine centre in NCoE Lucknow and a multipurpose indoor sports hall in NSSC, Bangalore. These facilities will help in growing the government's athlete support landscape.
4. To strengthen the sports nutritional supplement landscape in the country, this Ministry, has partnered with National Institute of Pharmaceutical Education & Research and the Food Safety & Standards Authority of India by signing an MoU. The key objectives of this tripartite partnership are to strengthen the testing capacity of nutritional supplements, educate stakeholders, R&D in clean sport & Anti-Doping and enable easy access to safe, Dope-Free supplements for sportspersons.
5. To commemorate the 50th year of India-Korea diplomatic relations, All India Inter-SAI Taekwondo Championship was co-hosted by SAI and Korean Cultural Centre between 24th & 26th February 2023. In addition to the same, an MoU was signed between Korea National Sports University and Miranda House College for the revitalization of Taekwondo.

6. This ministry's initiative to promote the participation of women in sports continues with a total of 16 leagues in different sporting disciplines including Archery, Cycling, Fencing, Weightlifting, etc organized for different age groups at zonal and national levels under the Khelo India Scheme.
7. National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) organized a total of 17 Anti-Doping Education Awareness programmes across the country.
8. The 90th and the 91st Meetings of the Mission Olympics Cell (MOC) were held on 2nd February, 2023 and 15-16th February, 2023 respectively on various components of the Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS). Proposals worth ₹32,20,984/- from various athletes belonging to 08 sporting disciplines were approved.

- a) Under the Swachhta campaign, National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) office premises were cleaned and the cafeteria & reception were renovated. In addition to the above, it is also ensured that NADA's office premises are kept clean and hygienic.
- b) Swachhta Abhiyan is being carried out at Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) on a regular basis for a clean and hygienic campus.
- c) Special Swachhta campaigns are run on a regular basis by all Institutional/Regional Heads of SAI, Sr. Director (Stadia Division) and every division of Sports Authority of India.

6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies- SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.
