Monthly Report for the month of July, 2022

**Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports**

**1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:**

- a) The National Anti-Doping Bill 2021, which provides for a statutory framework for the functioning of the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA), National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) and other dope testing facilities, was passed in Lok Sabha on 27.07.2022, and subsequently in Rajya Sabha on 03.08.2022. The new law will pave the way for the creation of the National Board for Anti-Doping in Sports to regulate anti-doping activities in sports in the country.
- b) The 44<sup>th</sup> FIDE Chess Olympiad (28<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 to 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2022) was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 28.07.2022 at JLN Indoor Stadium, Chennai. Over 2000 participants from 188 countries participated in the event, the highest ever in the history of the Chess Olympiad.
- c) The Indian contingent for Commonwealth Games (CWG) 2022, Birmingham was sent off through an event organized on 07.07.2022 in New Delhi, graced by the Union Minister for Youth Affairs and Sports, the Secretary-General, Indian Olympics Association and other dignitaries.
- d) The Indian contingent started their campaign at the Commonwealth Games, 2022 by winning a total of 6 medals (including 3 Gold) in the first three days (29.07.2022 to 31.07.2022) of the Commonwealth Games, 2022. India proudly finished 4<sup>th</sup> in the final Medals Tally with 61 medals including 22 Gold. More details of India's performance at the CWG, 2022 will be shared in further correspondence.
- e) The other important activities during the period are as follows:
  - i. Union Minister for Youth Affairs and Sports felicitated the Fit India Quiz State-level winners at a ceremony organized by this Ministry in Mumbai on 21.07.2022. Cash prize amounting to Rs. 99 Lakhs was awarded to 72 students from 36 schools, who won the State-level competitions which were held earlier this year in the months of February and March. The Fit India Quiz has moved to the National-level phase now.
  - ii. The 78th and 79th Meetings of Mission Olympics Cell (MOC) were held on 07.07.2022 and 21.07.2022 on various components of the Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS), in which proposals for Rs. 53,42,976/- for 9 athletes of 5 Sports disciplines were approved.

- iii. The Indian Wrestling Contingent topped the medals tally of the Cadet (U-17) World Wrestling Championship held in Italy from 25th to 31st July, 2022. India bagged 28 medals in total including 14 Gold.
- iv. The 4th Scientific Advisory Board Meeting was held on 12th July, 2022 by National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) on the Research & Development activities, training and action plan going forward on Athlete passport management Unit.
- v. The Inaugural Khelo India Women's Fencing League was successfully organised between 25.07.2022 & 29.07.2022 at Talkatora Indoor Stadium, New Delhi.
- vi. Archery stars Deepika Kumari and Atanu Das kicked off the 'Meet The Champion' Programme in the state of Jharkhand at Delhi Public School, Ranchi on 12th July, 2022, to spread awareness on 'Santulit Aahar', fitness and sports.
- vii. Laxmibai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE), Gwalior successfully organized Arm Wrestling Championship between 24.07.2022 & 26.03.2022.

Following activities were conducted for the special campaign of Swachhta Abhiyan:

- a) The workstations and premises of NADA office were extensively cleaned by officials. Whitewashing and repair activities were carried out in the premise. Awareness initiatives were carried out to keep the workplace & home clean.
- b) Every week, Swachhta campaign is organised by all the Institutional/Regional Heads and Divisions of Sports Authority of India (SAI) across the country. The Staff & Athletes are actively engaged in cleanliness activities on their respective SAI campuses.

- c) Cleaning drive was carried out in the Lakshmbai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) premise through an external agency.

**6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:**

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies- SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.

**7. Information on specific steps taken for utilization of the Space Technology-based tools and applications in Governance and Development:**

The Project for geo-tagging of Sports Infrastructure across the country is under consideration. The technology to be used for geo-tagging of playfields is yet to be finalized in which space technology could be effectively utilized.
