

**Monthly Report for the month of May, 2023**

**Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports**

**1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:**

- a) The third edition of Khelo India University Games (KIUG) 2022 was successfully organized from 25<sup>th</sup> May to 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2023 in Uttar Pradesh. The event saw participation of around 4700 athletes from over 200 Universities across the country. This edition of the KIUG had 21 sporting disciplines organized in four cities namely, Lucknow, Varanasi, Gorakhpur and Noida. Punjab University finished at the top of the Medals tally with 69 Medals including 26 Gold Medals, followed by Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar and Jain University, Karnataka. The debut of water sports made this edition of KIUG more significant.
- b) Preparations are in full swing for the Asian Games at Hangzhou, China in September & October, 2023, and holistic support is being provided to athletes to ensure that they have access to state-of-the-art infrastructure, equipment, best-in-class training and support staff. Through Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS), athletes are being supported for specialized training, international exposure and participation in competitions. This includes India's top talents including Sh. Neeraj Chopra training at Kuortane, Finland and other TOPS athletes supported to train in countries like Italy, Taiwan etc.
- c) The Fit India Quiz 2022 commenced on 22nd May 2023, the upcoming rounds of which will be telecast this month on Doordarshan and various online platforms. The event will see participation of 348 schools that had cleared the preliminary rounds.
- d) To celebrate Mother's Day and to instil the significance of fitness in children, a campaign was kicked off on 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 in which Sports Authority of India (SAI) partnered with 10 fitness influencers to disseminate the message of fitness among infants, children and mothers through social media outreach.
- e) The Women's League is an ongoing exercise of this department to promote inclusivity in sports by increasing the women's participation. As part of this, 06 events in different sporting disciplines including Weightlifting, Wrestling, Cycling, and Hockey, were organized in different age groups.
- f) To popularize and promote indigenous sports and games, a social media drive was organized by FIT India mission between 25.05.2023 and 30.05.2023, where documentaries on various Indigenous Sports were disseminated across all social media platforms.
- g) The 96<sup>th</sup>, 97<sup>th</sup> and 98<sup>th</sup> Meetings of Mission Olympics Cell (MOC) were held on 03.05.2023-04.05.2023, 18.05.2023 and 25.05.2023 on various components of TOPS. Proposals from various athletes belonging to 09 sporting disciplines worth Rs. 1,28,09,939/- were approved.

Following activities were conducted for the special campaign of Swachhta Abhiyan:

- a) Monthly campaigns are run by SAI in Delhi and in all its regional centres by carrying out cleaning, sanitization and disinfection of the respective premises.
- b) Under Swachhta Campaign, the office premises of National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) including workstations, electrical and Dope-kit rooms were cleaned with the active participation of the staff members.
- c) Cleaning and sanitization drive was carried out on the entire premise of the Lakshmbai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE).

**6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:**

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies- SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.
