Monthly Report for the month of September, 2022

**Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports**

**1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:**

- a) The 36<sup>th</sup> National Games, 2022 were inaugurated on 29<sup>th</sup> September by Hon'ble Prime Minister in a ceremony held in Ahmedabad in the presence of the Union Minister for Youth Affairs & Sports along with other dignitaries. Over 15,000 sportspersons, coaches, and officials from all the States & UTs across the country took part in 36 sports disciplines, making it the biggest National Games ever. It is noteworthy that this ministry has played an important role in the conduct of the Games, which were relaunched after a gap of seven years.
- b) On 14<sup>th</sup> September, 2022, a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed by the National Sports Development Fund (NSDF), a scheme of this Ministry, with the National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) Foundation and the Rural Electrification Corporation (REC) Foundation, at New Delhi, amounting to a total contribution of Rs. 215 crores for the development of sports in the country. NTPC will be supporting the sports discipline of Archery for the next five years and the REC Foundation has committed to support the disciplines of Hockey (for women), Athletics and Boxing for the next three years.
- c) Over 450 applications for the National Sports Awards, 2022 viz. the Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratan Award, the Arjuna Award, and other awards have been received till 1<sup>st</sup> of October, 2022. The awards ceremony is proposed to be held by the end of November, 2022.
- d) As a special effort for encouraging women in sports, various Women's Leagues have been launched in the past year under the Khelo India 'Promotion of Inclusiveness through Sports' vertical. As a part of this, the Women's Volleyball League (Senior) was successfully conducted at Kolkata, West Bengal between 29.08.2022 to 02.09.2022. Similarly, the Women's Open Boxing Championship (East Zone) was successfully conducted at SAI NCoE Guwahati, Assam between 16.09.2022 and 22.09.2022. In order to further boost this activity, the 36th Departmental Project Approval Committee (DPAC) of the Khelo India Scheme approved the proposal to organize Women's League in various sports, including Kho Kho, Kabaddi, Wushu and Football.
- e) Under the Khelo India Scheme, a total of 17 Khelo India Centres (KICs) have been designated in the states of Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh and Nagaland during this month. With this addition, as on date, the total number of Khelo India centres in the country has gone up to 685, which includes 76 centres of the Indian Railways.
- f) This Ministry, through its FIT India Programme, has collaborated for the Pan-India Motorbike Expedition involving 75 bikers (including 10 female bikers) to cover

21,000+ kms in 75 days, i.e., from 9th September 2022 to 24th November 2022. The expedition is expected to cover 250+ districts in 34 States/UTs including 6 international borders disseminating the message of fitness and health amongst the people of the country. This is also being supported by organizing 75 local events throughout the expedition.

- g) A media campaign was carried out between 26<sup>th</sup>& 30<sup>th</sup> September by the SAI to promote the indigenous games of India, such as Kabaddi, Thang-Ta, Kho Kho, Gatka, etc.
- h) An important meeting was held at Lausanne, Switzerland on 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) with the Indian Olympic Association (IOA), and other stakeholders, including Govt. of India, to discuss the roadmap for major governance reforms in the IOA. The deadline for the reforms is set by the IOC as the date of the next meeting of the Executive Board of the IOC, which is to be held in early December, 2022.
- i) Setting a new fitness benchmark for all, Fit India Mission of the Department of Sports, in association with the Ministry of Law and Justice, organized a first-of-its-kind Inter-Ministry, Bar & Bench Badminton Championship on 17<sup>th</sup>& 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2022, in which ministers, judges, and lawyers participated actively.
- j) National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) organized a total of 21 Anti-Doping Education Awareness programmes across the country in this month.

The following activities were conducted for the special campaign of Swachhta Abhiyan:

- a) Under Swachhta Campaign, the office premises of NADA including record rooms, inventory storage spaces, & workstations of officials were cleaned. The officials were encouraged to maintain clean and hygienic premises.
- b) Cleanliness drive was carried out in various Sports Authority of India (SAI) campuses across the country.

- c) Similar drive was carried out in the National Dope Testing Laboratory, New Delhi and Lakshmibai National Institute of Physical Education, Gwalior.

**6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:**

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies- SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.

**7. Information on specific steps taken for utilization of the Space Technology based tools and applications in Governance and Development:**

The geo-tagging of sporting infrastructure across the country is under consideration.
