Monthly Report for the month of January, 2022

**Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports**

**1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during January, 2022:**

- (a) For Development of the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium through Public-Private Partnership (PPP), based on the Request for Proposal (RFP) for appointment of Transaction Adviser (TA) floated in July 2021, a Transaction Advisor has been appointed.
- (b) Strengthening support for sports in India, the Union Government approved continuation of Scheme of Assistance to National Sports Federations (NSFs) with an outlay of Rs. 1575 crore and Khelo India Scheme with an an outlay of ₹3165.50 crore for the 15th Finance Commission Cycle (2021-22 to 2025-26). These are the two flagship schemes of the Department for promotion of the culture of sports and excellence in sports.
- (c) WADA Accreditation and Compliance with International Standard for Laboratories (ISLs):
  - WADA reinstated accreditation of National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) on 23 December, 2021. This reinstatement allows the NDTL to resume its anti-doping activities, including the analysis of urine and blood samples from NADA, etc.
  - NDTL has synthesized a new reference material (Norfenefrine Sulphate) with collaboration of NIPER (Guwahati).
- (d) Mission Olympic Cell Meeting (MOC) was held on 06.01.2022 to induct/retain athletes in Target Olympic Podium Scheme. Total 105 athletes were inducted in TOPS Core Group and 244 athletes were inducted in TOPS Development Group in the aforesaid Meeting.

**4. Particulars of cases in which there has been a departure from the Transaction of Business Rules or established policy of the Government:**

**5. Status of ongoing Swachhta Abhiyan (progress under Special Campaign):**

Following activities were conducted for the special campaign of ongoing Swachhta Abhiyan:

- (a) Monthly extensive cleaning by all staffs in the office cleaning of workstation by all the officials and cleaning of table drawers by all officers in NDTL.
- (b) Washrooms were done up and cleaning of vertical blinders/windows. Display of signage boards like 'No Smoking Area' and 'Do Not litter', etc, has been carried out in National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA).
- (c) Swachhta Abhiyan was performed and the garbage disposed off. The Entire premise of the Lakshmbai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) is kept clean and hygienic for which outsource agency has been engaged to carry out cleaning/sweeping of the entire premise regularly. Besides this, the Institute has commissioned roof-top solar power plant and water harvesting systems are also in place in the buildings as well as grounds so that the drain water is not wasted.
- (d) Special Campaign for Swachhta has been run by all the Institutional/Regional Head and Sr. Director Stadia Division and every division of Sports Authority of India. In their respective premises, Awareness posters of Swachhta among residents/visitors/Sportspersons were displayed at Regional centres. One day in a week has been designated for Removal of garbage/debris from premises of SAI Centres every month. Also, utmost attention is given for the cleanliness of campuses of each Regional Centres.

**6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:**

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies- SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.

**7. Information on specific steps taken for utilization of the Space Technology based tools and applications in Governance and Development:**

- (a) The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) has launched 'DCO Central', its new paperless doping control, sample collection app. 'DCO Central' provides Doping Control Officers (DCOs) from Anti-Doping Organizations (ADOs) and Sample Collection Agencies (SCAs) with an online and offline solution for secure and fast data collection. National Anti-Doping Agency is adopting the above paper less Dope Control process and a pilot process has been initiated to adopt the process.
- (b) Proposal to GEO tagging sports infrastructure across the county is under progress through Sports Authority of India.

**8. Vacancy position of senior level appointments in the Ministry/Department, including Autonomous Bodies/PSUs:**

- (a) There is no vacancy of senior level appointments in Department of Sports.
- (b) The post of CEO & DG NADA is vacant since 13.04.2021. Ministry has taken up the matter with DoPT for posting a suitable incumbent.
- (c) Vacancy position of senior level posts in NDTL is as per **Annexure-II**. Process is underway for filling up the vacancies at various levels.
- (d) Appointment of Regular Vice-Chancellor, LNIPE Gwalior is under process. Officiating charge of VC has been given to one of the Professors of the institute.
- (e) Vacancy position of senior level posts in NADA is as per **Annexure-III**.
- (f) Vacancy position of senior level posts in SAI is as per **Annexure-IV**.

**10. Details of FDI proposals cleared during the month and status of FDI proposals awaiting approval in the Ministry / Department:**

One FDI proposal was received during the month of January and is awaiting approval of the Minister (YA&S).

Details of the Proposal:

FDI proposal No. 5531 of City Football Group for investment of Rs. 120 crore in Mumbai City Football Private Limited was considered by Inter Ministerial Committee (IMC) chaired by Home Secretary at its meeting held on 4.2.2022. FDI proposal of City Football Group has been recommended by IMC subject to the condition that subsequent to the approval, any further investment does not result in any increase in the prevailing shareholding percentage/stake of the shareholder(s)/investor(s) from country(ies) sharing land border with India; and does not vest new rights or entitlements which result in transfer of control of the Indian investee entity in favour of shareholder(s)/investor(s)/beneficial owner(s) from country(ies) sharing land border with India.
