Annexure-I**Monthly Report for the month of December, 2022****Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports****1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:**

- a) In the run-up to the prestigious FIH Odisha Hockey Men's World Cup 2023 Bhubaneswar – Rourkela, a nationwide Trophy Tour was kicked off in Bhubaneswar on 5th December by the Chief Minister of Odisha. The coveted trophy traversed 13 states and one Union Territory before concluding its journey in Odisha on 25th December. The World Cup begins on 13th January 2023.
- b) On 17th December, 2022, the Hon'ble Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports inaugurated various projects at Sports Authority of India's (SAI) Netaji Subhas National Institute of Sports (NSNIS) in Patiala and National Regional Centre (NRC) in Sonipat. The inaugurated projects include a 300 bedded Hostel (constructed at a cost of ₹26.77 crore) and newly renovated hostels (constructed at a cost of Rs. 5.25 Cr.) in Patiala. Foundation Stone was laid for the development of an Integrated High-Performance Centre (HPC) at a cost of Rs.48 Cr. The Hon'ble Minister also inaugurated the refurbished synthetic Hockey Field at NRC, Sonipat, Haryana.
- c) The revamped Khelo India Dashboard was launched by the Hon'ble Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports on 23rd December, 2022 in New Delhi. The dashboard is a one-stop shop for all statistical data on the flagship Khelo India scheme and Events, updated on a real-time basis. The dashboard, which is accessible to the citizens of the country, will serve as a platform for the citizens to be sensitized about various programs of the Khelo India scheme.
- d) To strengthen the focus and channelize efforts on anti-doping education and mechanism for athletes with disabilities, the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA) hosted a first-of-its-kind Inclusion Conclave on 02.12.2022. Participants from India and 20 other nations actively participated in the conclave, thus, strengthening the collective effort towards an inclusive anti-doping landscape in the country.
- e) During the month, the Indian Blind Cricket team won the T-20 World Cup finals defeating Bangladesh for the 3rd consecutive time, which is a commendable feat. This team was felicitated by the Hon'ble Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India. Similarly, more than 60,000 students from 16,702 schools participated in the preliminary rounds of the Fit India Quiz, 2022 organized by the National Testing Agency in a Mobile Based Multi-lingual format.
- f) NADA organized a total of 14 Anti-Doping Education Awareness programmes across the country.
- g) In a significant step towards strengthening the athlete support ecosystem, cadre restructuring activity was carried out where 12 Chief Coaches of Sports Authority of India (SAI) were promoted to High-Performance Coaches, equivalent to the scale of Director, Government of India.
- h) The 87th and 88th Meeting of Mission Olympics Cell (MOC) were held on 6-7 December, 2022 and 21st December 2022 on various components of Target Olympic

Podium Scheme (TOPS). Proposals from various athletes belonging to 8 sporting disciplines worth Rs. 56,26,676/- were approved.

Following activities were conducted for the special campaign of Swachhta Abhiyan:

- a) Under Swachhta Campaign, the office premises of NADA and NDTL including workstations, stores and conference rooms were cleaned. The staff of NADA and NDTL actively engaged in Swachhta drives.
- b) Under the swachhta campaign, a cleaning drive was organised at LNIPE where the entire premise of was cleaned during the month of December.
- c) In the month of December, Swachhta drives were organized at Sports Authority of India (SAI) campuses across the country. Cleaning, sanitization and disinfection drives were carried out in hostels, playfields and workspaces.

6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies- SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.
