Wishing you the very best and looking forward to see you on our campus.



National Sports University Society contributes to promoting and developing sports and making our country and society wealthy by nurturing mentally and physically healthy students with outstanding character.

Mission

1. We focus on studying the human potential holistically by conducting pioneering research in the field of sport science and putting it into practice to improve citizens' physical strength and enhance athletes' competitive abilities internationally.
2. We contribute to maintaining international peace with the power of sports by deepening and developing the sports culture in India and promoting the Olympic movement.
3. We produce top athletes as well as individuals who earnestly act as leaders in local communities to create a healthy, rich sports society.

Vision

National Sport University Society aims to be a leading university in preparing world class athlete, sport scientist, physical educationist and using our original creative educational system and research to realize forthcoming knowledge-based society and promote local development.

KEY FUNCTIONS OF THE PROPOSED UNIVERSITY

A. Academics

The University shall impart Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral programmes in Sports Coaching, Sports Sciences, and Physical Education in various disciplines.

Specialized degree programmes in various Sports Education and Coaching disciplines are also envisaged for the future.

B. Research

The University shall focus on collaborating with leading researchers in India and abroad to undertake cutting-edge research programmes and exchange of information in various research areas, especially in the field of sports coaching and performance enhancement of athletes.

C. Performance

One of the important functions of the University shall be to conduct sports training programmes to enable athletes to enhance their performance and achieve excellence in sports.

D. Serving for the community

The University shall provide extension services for the local community to improve upon their health and life style in addition to further promoting sports of local origin.

1.1 CAMPUS

The National Sport University has its temporary campus located in Khuman Lampak, Imphal at about 10 kilometers from the Imphal airport, in the state of Manipur.

The permanent Campus is under construction at "Kotruk" near Imphal in an area of about 300 acres of land

1.2 UNDER-GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

The Institute offers two programmes from the year 2017-18 to cater to the growing demand of Coaches and Physical Education teachers in schools and other institutions.

The following programmes are on the offer at the under-graduate level for the academic year 2017-'18:

a) B.Sc. in Sports Coaching: Duration-4 years (8 semesters)

b) B.P.E.S: Duration-3 years (6 semesters)

1.3 HOSTEL AND MESS

It is mandatory for all the students pursuing full-time B.Sc. (Sports Coaching) and B.P.E.S. to reside at the University hostels and take their meals in the mess.

A booklet containing rules and regulations regarding discipline and conduct at the University hostels and mess is given to the students at the time of admission. Every student is expected to read the booklet thoroughly and understand these rules and regulations.

NOTE:

- **Ragging of any kind is strictly prohibited/banned in the University campus as per the government orders and existing laws. Anybody found indulging in ragging shall be strictly dealt with as per the existing laws.**
- **As per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the University authorities, the concerned student/s shall be given the liberty to explain and if his explanation is not found satisfactory, the University would not hesitate to expel such student/s from the Institute, without further notice.**
- **As per the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions (2009) as amended from time to time, all the students enrolled in various courses and their parents shall submit separate affidavits in prescribed formats, which are available on the Institute website as well as in the Prospectus.**
- **For maintaining peace and tranquility and for disciplinary reasons, no student is permitted to keep any motor vehicle in the hostels, including bikes, scooters, etc. Violation of this rule shall invite severe punishment to the extent of expulsion from the Institute.**

1.4 CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The University promotes cultural and literary activities through the Cultural Club and Literary Society respectively, by providing the students an opportunity to participate in dramatics, music, debates, symposia, quiz competitions, etc. The students are also involved extensively in activities like Camping, Outreach Activities and

Adventure Programmes to develop leadership qualities and all-round personality development.

1.5 SPORTS PARTICIPATION

Competitive sports are an integral part of the academic programme of the University. The students may directly participate in the Inter University Tournaments in various games and sports as also at different levels as per the University policy.

1.6 ADMISSION AND RESERVATIONS

The University is co-educational and admits candidates who are citizen of India. For all courses, the reservation policy of Government of India is applicable.

1.7 APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Admission Form, Fee, Syllabus, Eligibility Criterion and Rules are available on the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports website www.yas.nic.in or can be obtained from the Office at Khuman Lampak, Imphal, during working days from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Admission forms can be downloaded from this Ministry's website www.yas.nic.in.

Duly filled-in admission forms along with the requisite fee and related documents should be sent to Deputy Secretary (Sports), Department of Sports, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports (MYAS), Room No. 520, C-Wing, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi 110001, on or before **01/12/2017**. Contact no: 011- 23383336, E-mail: sunil.garg@nic.in

Admission test, including physical assessment, will be held on 10.12.2017 from 10.00 AM onwards, at Imphal, Guwahati, Kolkata, Bangalore, Thiruvananthapuram, Gandhinagar, Gwalior and Patiala.

Application fee to be paid only by Demand Draft in favour of National Sports University Society payable at New Delhi.

Note:

1. International Athletes can get direct admission to both the courses provided that the competition they have participated is approved by AIU / Concerned Federation/ Association.

2. Achievements in sports at National Level will be an added advantage. Tuition-fee waiver for Athletes who have participated in international competitions will be considered based on their participation/ achievement in such events during the last three years.

The candidates are advised to go through the instructions given in the application, as well as in the Prospectus before submission of application.

1.8 DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ENTRANCE TEST

All eligible candidates (as per the requirement of the particular course) shall report for the admission test at the respective test centres on their own along with the following documents:-

- a. Photo Identity Proof in original (as mentioned in the application form) along with one self-attested Photostat copy of the same.**
- b. Medical Fitness Certificate in prescribed format.**

Please note that no pick-up and drop facility shall be provided to the candidates. No TA/DA will be given for appearing in the test.

1.9 GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION

The following conditions of admission shall apply to all the candidates seeking admission in different courses:-

- Candidates expelled from any other Board/Institute/University or dismissed from Government service on disciplinary grounds and those who are known to have been involved in acts of crime and gross indiscipline or misconduct will not be eligible for admission. The University may approach the police for verification in this regard. After admission, if anybody is found guilty in this regard, he/she will have to discontinue the course.
- ***The medium of examination shall be either Hindi or English for all the courses.***
- Admission will be granted to the candidates at their own risk and responsibility as per details furnished by them. If, at any time, it is noticed that the admission has been obtained by giving incorrect or false information or concealing information or oversight, the admission granted will be cancelled and the candidate shall be asked to leave the University.
- All the selected candidates will be required to submit attested copies of the following documents along with their respective originals for verification at the time of taking admission after due

process of counselling within the stipulated time period for this purpose:-

- Mark-sheet of the qualifying examination.
- Proof of date of birth (Mark-sheet of Secondary/Senior Secondary examination).
- Character certificate from the Institute last attended.
- Affidavits of self and parents regarding Anti- Ragging in the prescribed format **Annexure - II (A) & (B)**.
- Bonafide SC / ST/OBC certificate, if applicable, in prescribed format **Annexure - III & IV**.
- Declaration regarding non-creamy layer (applicable for OBC candidates only) in prescribed format **Annexure - V**.
- Transfer Certificate and Migration Certificate from the Board/University/Institute last attended.**Annexure - VI**.
- Declaration of Self and Parents for Medical Fitness at the time of Admission **Annexure - VII**.
- Physical performance tests during the admission process may involve risk of injury or physical strain. The Society does not take any responsibility in the event of any such eventuality.
- Candidates failing to meet the stipulated guidelines in the qualifying examination shall not be eligible to appear in the admission test. Similarly, ineligible candidates (those who fail to deposit the required documents by the stipulated date), even after attaining a position in the merit list among provisionally selected candidates, shall not be eligible for admission.
- Candidates should be appropriately dressed to undergo Entrance Test/Physical Fitness/Sport Proficiency Test.

1.10 SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

- The selection of candidates on the basis of the entrance testshall be made through the process of counseling.
- The eligibility of candidates to appear in counseling shall bedeclared in their respective categories, which shall be purelyprovisional and on the basis of declarations made by thecandidates in their application forms. Therefore, thecandidates are advised to fill-in the form carefully. If acandidate declares him/her belonging to reserved categorybut the appropriate documents are not up to the satisfactionof the society or have not been submitted at the time ofadmission, then his/her provisional selection in thatcategory shall stand cancelled automatically.
- The selected candidates will be required to undergo a medicaltest to be conducted by the Institute. All those who arecertified as medically fit by the Institute's doctors will befinally admitted.

1.11 PAYMENT OF FEES

The finally selected candidates shall be required to pay the fee as mentioned in the fee structure under **Annexures**. Ifor various courses. In case any student fails to deposit the fee within the

stipulated period, his/her admission shall stand cancelled and other candidates will be admitted through counseling.

1.12 ATTENDANCE, CODE OF CONDUCT, REFUND OF FEE AND CAUTION MONEY

1.12.1.1 The University expects 100% attendance from the students in each subject/activity/area of the total curriculum but, due to medical leave/social engagements leave/personal leave, etc., a relaxation of 15% will be given. Prior to one month from the date of semester examinations the student must have complete 85% attendance. In exceptional and deserving cases, the Authority may give further relaxation of up to 10% in attendance. All faculty members shall submit the attendance every day to the concerned authority.

1.12.2 The students should conduct themselves in an exemplary manner so as to be model for other students.

1.12.3 All the students should strictly adhere to the rules and regulations of the University.

1.12.4 RAGGING: The candidates should not indulge or participate in any kind of ragging. If they are found to have indulged in ragging in the past, or noticed later, the candidates will be removed from the roll of the institution at whatever stage of study and criminal action will be taken against the candidates.

1.12.5 If any student is involved in ragging or any other anti-social activities, he/she will be expelled and criminal proceedings may be launched against him/her.

1.12.6 The students should be present during all working days and sincerely apply themselves to studies.

1.12.7 The students should attend the classes regularly and punctually and should fulfill the attendance requirement of 75% as prescribed by the university, to be eligible to appear for the university examinations.

1.12.8 The campus is “Tobacco Free” and “Liquor Free”. Any violation of this will result in dismissal from the programme.

1.12.9 Use of mobile phones and other electronic gadgets are not permitted in the class rooms, examination halls, faculty premises, society organized programmes of importance.

1.12.10 The students are forbidden from using motorized vehicles, including powered two wheelers, inside the campus.

1.12.11 Refund of fee to the students shall be regulated as per the UGC norms as revised from time to time.

1.12.12 Refund of caution money (if due) shall be made by the society only after the declaration of the final result of the course and

on production of the no dues certificate.

1.12.13 Students are advised to visit notice boards regularly, displayed at different places pertaining to academic matters.

1.13 SPORTS EQUIPMENT

All the students have to procure personal equipment as specified for different games/sports on their own.

1.14 CLOTHING AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Due to extreme weather conditions at Imphal, Manipur the temperature ranges between 16⁰C and 35⁰C in summers, and 4⁰C and 25⁰C in winters. Hence, the students are advised to bring appropriate bedding and clothing.

1.15 AWARD OF DEGREE

The selected candidates shall be awarded the Degree to which they have been admitted subject to successful completion of the examination as per requirements prescribed under the rules/scheme of examination of the relevant courses.

The duration of the B.Sc. (Sports Coaching) Course is 4 years (8 semesters). A candidate must complete the Course and pass the final examination within eight academic years from the first admission to B.Sc. Programme.

2.3 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1. A pass in Higher Secondary (10th and +2 scheme of examination or any other equivalent examination recognised by the University) for admission into the 4 years B.Sc. degree.
2. The age of candidates shall be above 17 years. The relaxation of minimum age is permissible with the prior permission of the Director.
3. Admission shall be made on merit on the basis of marks obtained in the entrance test (written test, sports proficiency test, physical fitness test & marks obtained in the qualifying examination) or any other selection process as per the policy of University with due weight for physical fitness test.
4. *Admission Test and Interview:* For admission into the first year B.Sc. Programme, the tests consists of

1. Physical Fitness	20 marks
2. Written Test	40 marks
3. Games/Sports SkillAbility	40 marks
5. Other conditions to be fulfilled by each candidate.
 - i) Must have represented the School/District in the Inter School/District Competition in any one of the Games or Sports.

 - iii) Should secure at least 45% of marks in the selection tests to be conducted by the Society as indicated below:
