Subject: Renewal of recognition of All India Football Federation, reg.

Sir,

The matter regarding renewal of recognition to All India Football Federation (AIFF) has been examined. Vide letter no. 9-12/2017 dated 01.02.2019 the annual recognition of AIFF for the year 2019 was renewed. While considering the matter, it has been noticed that the last election of AIFF conducted on 21.12.2016, which was challenged by the Petitioner in WP(C) No. 195/2010. While pronouncing its judgment/order dated 31.10.2017 in CM 46919/2016 & CM 19815/2012 in WP(C) No. 195/2010 -Rahul Mehra vs UOI & Ors., the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi set aside the election result declared on 21.12.2016. The Hon'ble High Court appointed Dr. SY Quraishi as Administrator-cum-Returning Officer for conduct of elections of AIFF as per the timelines prescribed in the said order. The said Judgment/Order dated 31.12.2016 was challenged by AIFF in SLP (C) Nos. 30748-30749/2017 before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dated 10.11.2017 stayed the operation of the impugned judgment /order dated 31.12.2016. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dated 10.11.2017 appointed Dr. SY Qureshi and Mr. Bhaskar Ganguly as the Committee of Administrators (Ombudsmen) for formulation of Constitution of AIFF to be in consonance with the National Sport Code and the Model Guidelines for the conduct of its business, constitution of the Executive Committee and elections thereto, whilst ensuring that the status and membership of AIFF is not undermined in any manner in the International body. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dated 10.11.2017 specified that the directions issued in paragraph 22 (containing directions for appointment of Administrator-cum-Returning Officer and elections of AIFF) of the impugned judgment/order be remain in abeyance until further orders. Since then no further order has been passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. The matter is still sub-judice before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

2. Upon consideration of matter in entirety, it has been decided to renew the recognition of All India Football Federation for one year with effect from date of issue of this letter, subject to any outcome of SLP pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

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3. It has been noticed that constitution / MoA of the All India Football Federation needs to be aligned with the provisions of the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011 (Sports Code). Accordingly, All India Football Federation is required to make categorical affirmation of the provisions of the Sports Code in its constitution within 6 months so as to bring the same fully in line with the Sports Code. The Federation is also required to take necessary steps for uploading of the information in compliance to the instructions as contained in this Ministry's letter no. 9-7/2014-SP.I dated 26.02.2015 on suo-moto disclosure within 3 months' time (copy enclosed).

Sub: Information to be hosted mandatorily by IOA & NSFs on their website - reg.

Sir,

Reference is invited to this Ministry's letter No. 9-69/2009-SP.I dated 29th November, 2010 and letter No. 8-20/2014-SP-III dated 15th October, 2014 wherein IOA and NSFs were asked to furnish the information to this office and to suo-moto disclose their various activities carried out by them. All these instructions have also been made part of the National Sports Development Code of India, 2011 (copies enclosed)

- 2. It has been noticed that although some of the NSFs are furnishing the required information to this office, it is not available on the websites of many NSFs and hence is not available to general public and stake holders.
- 3. In a recent case of Badminton Association of India vs. Union of India, the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has taken a serious view about non furnishing of information under RTI Act by the NSFs. Hence the court has passed an order dated 24th December, 2014 in W.P.(C) No.9318/2014 stating, inter-alia, that this would be an appropriate case where Government of India should examine the manner in which the NSF is functioning.
- 4. Therefore, in order to reduce the paper work of NSFs while making the information available to stakeholders regarding the functioning of NSFs and IOA it has been decided that henceforth the information as per the enclosed list shall be uploaded on the website of IOA and the respective NSFs.
- 5. All these information should be made available on the website latest by 1.4.2015. Further, the website must be updated by IOA & NSFs as frequently as possible and atleast once in a fortnight.
- 6. Vide order No.8-20/2014-SP-III dated 15.10.2014 it was informed that the NSFs shall post their audited accounts and the Balance Sheet of the previous year by 30th June of the current year. It was brought to the notice of this Ministry that finalisation of audited

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accounts and balance sheet takes time and it is not possible to post the same on the website by 30th June. In view of this, it has been decided that the annual accounts of the previous financial year should be posted by the IOA & NSFs during the current year as soon as it is finalised but latest by 31st December of the current year.

- 7. Consolidated list of information to be uploaded on the website of IOA & NSFs is enclosed.
- 8. It is also informed that annual recognition for the year 2015 may be reviewed in case the above instructions are not complied with by 1.4. 2015.
- 9. This issues with the approval of Secretary (Sports).
