Annexure-IMonthly Report for the month of May, 2022

**Name of the Ministry / Department: Department of Sports**

**1. Important policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:**

a) Two historic events in the field of sports in the country occurred in the month of May, 2022. For the first time in the history of the prestigious international Thomas Cup (Badminton) tournament, the Indian men's team won the championship by defeating 14-time World Champion Indonesia at Bangkok, Thailand. To mark this historic occasion, the Hon'ble Prime Minister met and felicitated the team members on 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2022. The Indian women's Badminton team, which participated in the Uber Cup Championship, was also felicitated. Similarly, the Indian contingent for Deaflympics, Brazil 2021, was felicitated on 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2022 by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, for giving the best-ever performance for the country where they won 16 medals (8 Gold, 1 Silver and 7 Bronze).

b) The Department has given in-principle approval for the following 6 leagues to promote sports among women under the Khelo India Scheme:-

- Khelo India Junior Girls & Youth Women Open Boxing Championship
- Khelo India Women's Cycling League
- Khelo India Women's Ranking Judo Tournament
- Khelo India Junior Women's Swimming Challenge Series
- Khelo India Women's Volleyball League
- Khelo India Women's Wrestling National Tournament.

c) Other important activities during the period:

- (i) The 61<sup>st</sup> Foundation Day of the Netaji Subhas National Institute of Sports (NSNIS), Patiala, was celebrated on 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2022. Government is investing more than Rs. 150 crore over a period of three years for revamping this apex sports institution of the country.
- (ii) The foundation stone of the Sports Authority of India National Centre of Excellence (SAI-NCOE) in Cooch Behar, West Bengal, was laid on 21.05.2022. A Memorandum of Understanding was also signed between SAI and the Ministry of Railways on the occasion.
- (iii) Yog Mahotsav was organized in the run up to the International Day of Yoga on June 21, and was held simultaneously in Dharamshala and New Delhi on 14.05.2022, with more than 2000 athletes and yoga practitioners as participants.
- (iv) 35 new State Level Khelo India Centres in the states of Haryana, Kerala and Uttarakhand were sanctioned.
- (v) Archery Association of India (AAI) organized the Khelo India Zonal Archery Tournament across 5 National Centres of Excellence (NCOE) of SAI on May

Day. A total of 586 archers participated in the Tournament held in Sonapat, Imphal, Kolkata, Guwahati and Aurangabad.

- (vi) The Mission Olympics Meeting was held on 05.05.2022-06.05.2022 and subsequently on 26.05.2022 to review the preparations for the forthcoming Asian Games and Commonwealth Games.
- (vii) The National Anti-Doping Agency organized a brain storming session on 13.05.2022 at the India Habitat Centre with all National Sports Federations to discuss the strategies for clean sports and effective implementation of Anti-Doping Programme.
- (viii) Under the 'Meet the Champions' campaign, Arif Mohammad Khan (Winter Games Olympian) visited SP Higher Secondary School in Srinagar, J&K and Ladakh on 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2022. Besides Md. Khan, other elite athletes also visited various schools as under:
  - i. Sarthak Bhabri (Sprinter) - Govt. Model High School, Chandigarh on 07.05.2022;
  - ii. Sumit Antil (Paralympian) – GMSS School, Panchkula on 10.05.2022; and
  - iii. Harvinder Singh (Paralympian Archer) - Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School, Amritsar, Punjab.

**5. Status of ongoing Swachhta Abhiyan (progress under Special Campaign):**

Following activities were conducted for the special campaign of Swachhta Abhiyan:

- a) Swachhta Abhiyan is being performed at the National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) on a regular basis and approximately 2.0 tons of garbage was removed in the month of May to keep the premises clean and hygienic.
- b) General cleaning work was carried out by the staff of National Anti-Doping Agency (NADA), which includes the cleaning of workstations, drawers, curtains and the complete premises of NADA.

- c) Swachhta Abhiyan is being carried out in Lakshmbai National Institute of Physical Education (LNIPE) every week to keep the premises clean and hygienic. There are water harvesting systems in place at almost all buildings as well as the grounds so that the rain water is not wasted in the campus.
- d) Swachhta Campaign is being run in all the Regional Offices and Divisions of Sports Authority of India (SAI) every week with the help of various public and private agencies to keep the premises clean, green and hygienic.
- e) Officials, staff and Athletes in all the units of SAI are spontaneously engaged in cleaning the office premises, fields, rooms as well as its surroundings. Campus cleaning, sanitization and disinfection works are carried out in hostels, play fields and other areas in SAI Campuses all across the country.

**6. Status of Rationalization of Autonomous Bodies:**

Does not arise in the case of D/o Sports as all the five Autonomous Bodies - SAI, LNIPE, National Sports University (NSU), NADA and NDTL have been set up for specific purposes.

**7. Information on specific steps taken for utilization of the Space Technology based tools and applications in Governance and Development:**

- a) NADA has launched a Dashboard for adopting paperless dope control process in which components of satellite navigation and geo-tagging are under integration.
- b) Geo-tagging of Playfields on pan-India basis is under process to enable users to search sports infrastructure facilities on the basis of their geographical location and other details. The Department has engaged professionals to perform the geo-tagging, on-site physical verification and compilation of the national database.
