

(iv) Directorate of Sports and Youth Welfare, Government of Madhya Pradesh should also certify that it has not obtained or applied for grants for the same purpose or activity from any other Ministry and Department of the Government of India or the State Government.

(v) The Grant-in-aid is further subject to the conditions laid down in General Financial Rules as amended from time to time.

(vi) The grantee will promote HIV/AIDS Awareness.

(vii) This is a recurring grant. The grantee shall submit the Utilization Certificate in the prescribed format immediately after the close of the financial year along with the audited statement of accounts. The Utilization Certificate should be checked and signed by an officer not below the rank of Director and counter signed by the Secretary, Directorate of Sports and Youth Welfare, Government of Madhya Pradesh. The subsidiary accounts of the Govt. grant to be maintained by the grantee as per Rule 210 of the GF Rules 2005 included as clause 3(ii) above. The UC should also disclose whether the specified, quantified and qualitative targets that should have been achieved against the amount utilized, were in fact achieved, and if not the reasons therefor.

(viii) The fact that the programme is sponsored by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and sports should be prominently highlighted and displayed while inviting people and holding functions/programmes/events etc.

(ix) Wherever the Government of India has reasons to believe that the sanctioned money is not being utilized for the approved purposes, the payment of the grant shall be stopped forthwith and shall issue a show cause notice to the grantee. If the reply to the show cause notice is not satisfactory, the earlier grant will be recovered with interest as mentioned in Clause 3 (ii) above.

(x) It may be ensured that the sanctioned programme (s) is started within one month from the date of the receipt of the funds and the amount of the grant is utilized before 31st March 2014.


(xi) The grantee institution/organization should exercise reasonable economy while implementing the approved project.

(xii) No asset should be created out of this grant.

4. It is certified that no UC is outstanding against Directorate of Sports and Youth Welfare, Government of Madhya Pradesh for the grant released under PYKKA Scheme, during previous years.

5. The Directorate of Sports and Youth Welfare, Government of Madhya Pradesh shall release the funds to the village level and block level implementation agencies within 15 days of from the Central Government.

6. The sanction is being issued in exercise of the delegated powers and in conformity with the rules and principles as approved by the Ministry of Finance. It is also certified that the pattern of assistance has the approval of the competent authority.
